### 2418 Fields for Playoff games

For a playoff game, the host (home) team must provide a field with all required lacrosse lines. This includes the end lines, sidelines, restraining box lines, wing lines and creases. These lines must either be painted, taped or part of the permanent lines on the field. Portable creases and cones do not suffice. The home team may exhaust all options to provide a field up to 48 hours prior to the scheduled start. If field cannot be provided the visiting team should host.

**MOTION: It was moved by D.H. and seconded by J.B. to accept the above parameters for a playoff field. In favor 7. Opposed 0. Motion carried.**
